



CUSHION SNAP INSTALLATION



1. Each cushion has either two or four snaps that correlate to where it connects to the frame



2. Line up the cushion to where the snaps meet the frame. You can slide your hand underneath the black strap on the cushion where the snap is to firmly press it to the frame until you hear and feel it snap together.



3. To confirm the cushion is snapped in place, lightly pull up on the cushion. It should be able to be lifted up with some give without the snap releasing.

NOTE: To remove the cushion slide your hand underneath the black strap on the cushion where the snap meets the frame and pull up with direct force to release.

HOOK AND LOOP STRAP INSTALLATION



1. Configure your furniture in whatever way you see fit, without attaching the cushions. Make sure each frame is flush against each other.

NOTE: These hook and loop straps are only designed to attach frames together and should not be used to secure your furniture to other objects or frames.



2. With Aurora frames flush together, use two straps per edge that are being secured together. Looking down at the frames wrap one hook and loop strap around the two touching frames closest to the furthest edge from you. Wrap the second strap around the same two touching frames to the edge that is closest to you. Repeat this for all connection points on the frames.
